Subject: A Free and Confidential Site Visit for Printers

Could your company be saving thousands of dollars? Could you find and fix problems before they become fines? How would you like an environmental consultant to inspect your shop, point out problems and suggest remedies? What if this service was free and confidential?

This service is available to you right now! It's the **Compliance Commitment (C2)** program from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's (TCEQ) Small Business and Local Government Assistance (SBLGA) program. You can get an evaluation of your site's environmental compliance by having a site visit. After you correct any noted problems, a second visit evaluates compliance and demonstrates eligibility for C2.

Through the C2 program, small business owners and local governments can earn a **one year exemption from routine investigations**. This exemption is recognized by:

- TCEQ
- U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)
- City of Dallas
- City of El Paso
- City of Fort Worth
- City of Houston
- City of Corpus Christi Stormwater Department
- City of Pasadena
- Galveston County Health District
- Harris County Public Health & Environmental Services
